Jackson County Ordinance for Junk Yards

Section 42-63. Permitting and condition for operation of junkyards:

No junkyard shall be operated or maintained, or permitted to be operated or maintained, within the unincorporated area of Jackson County in the absence of a permit issued by the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County. The Jackson County Board of County Commissioners shall have the authority to issue a permit to maintain a junkyard, upon filing of an application with such support documentation as shall be necessary to show compliance with this ordinance and payment of an initial fee of \$100.00. All applications shall be filed by the owner or lessee of the property upon which the junkyard shall be located. All junkyards shall be located upon a single parcel, which shall consist of not less than five acres in size. Stored vehicles may not be stacked, placed or maintained in a manner so as to exceed a height of 20 feet above natural ground level. The perimeter of the junkyard shall not be located within 100 feet of any publicly maintained road, street or highway, nor within 100 feet of perimeter property line. The entire perimeter of the junkyard shall be surrounded by a manmade barrier or fence, which shall obscure visual observation of the site to a height of not less than six feet after construction. The barrier will also be augmented with vegetation to break up the barrier outline or assist in obscuring the site. The permit shall be renewable on a yearly basis upon review for compliance with all conditions hereof and a payment of an annual fee of \$50.00.

Section 42-64. Junkyards.

The provisions of section 42-63 shall be applicable to all junkyards located within the unincorporated area of Jackson County, whether or not in existence at the time of passage of this article; provided, that any junkyard in existence at the time of passage of the article shall comply with all requirements of Ordinance No. 87-8 as previously enacted.
